MOVED:

MTA will create a database of members and local leaders to speak on Special interest legislation. (for example a list of members that would be interested in speaking on a Proposal for retirement plus or a list of members that would like to speak on Ethnically Marginalized topics.) Data will be collected by an electronic survey.

SUBMITTER'S RATIONALE:

Whenever an issue being discussed at the State House is identified by MTA as requiring testimony at a hearing, they can use this list to quickly contact members and confirm their availability as soon as possible. While a general email can still be sent to the full membership inviting anyone interested to speak on the issue, this process ensures that MTA already has a list of interested members they can contact immediately, rather than having to search for volunteers on short notice.
