With the exception of items on the agenda, all substantive motions shall be submitted in writing to the Presiding Officer.

MOTION

MOVED:

That the Massachusetts Teachers Association develop and implement a process through which members may voluntarily opt out of receiving routine paper mail communications and instead receive such communications electronically whenever feasible. This opt-out shall not apply to: - Annual Meeting materials; - official election materials and candidate literature; or - any communications required by law, policy, or governing documents to be distributed in paper form. The Association shall continue to provide paper communications to members who prefer or require them.

SUBMITTER'S RATIONALE:

Providing members with the option to receive routine communications electronically would reduce printing and mailing costs, lessen environmental impact, and align Association communication practices with modern member preferences. This proposal maintains necessary paper distribution for key democratic and governance functions while allowing members greater flexibility in how they receive routine communications.
